We would like to offer your child the chance to join us on a residential experience at Lockerbrook Farm Outdoor Centre, Derbyshire for a one night stay on the following days:

There will be the possibility of adding an additional date of Monday 15th May 2018, this is depending on pupil numbers. Once we have final numbers, your child will be allocated a date and we will notify you of this.

The intention of the residential is to provide the children with enriched opportunities in team building skills as well as outdoor geography and science activities (as detailed in the itinerary attached).

The cost for the stay will be £58.00. This includes transport, accommodation, meals and all activities. This is an exciting opportunity for your child to extend and enrich their learning experiences beyond the school environment and we are sure the visit will be a memorable one.

As this trip will form part of the curriculum for the half term, we would encourage all children to attend and we have planned the residential for one night per class so that every child has access to this opportunity.

At this stage we require a non-refundable deposit of £20.00. To secure a place for you child please log on to School Gateway and make payment of £20.00 by Monday 29th January 2018.
